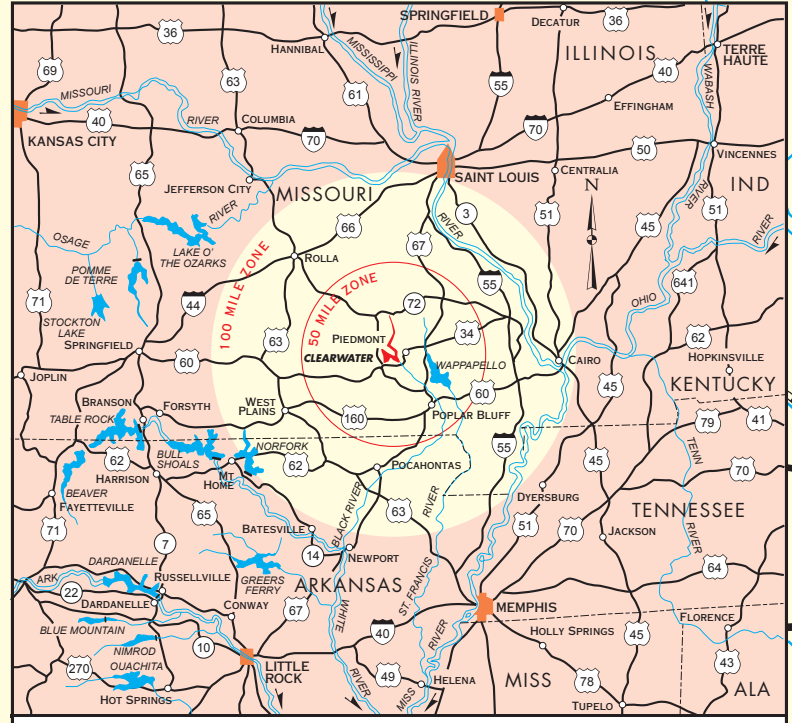


Know Your Park Rules

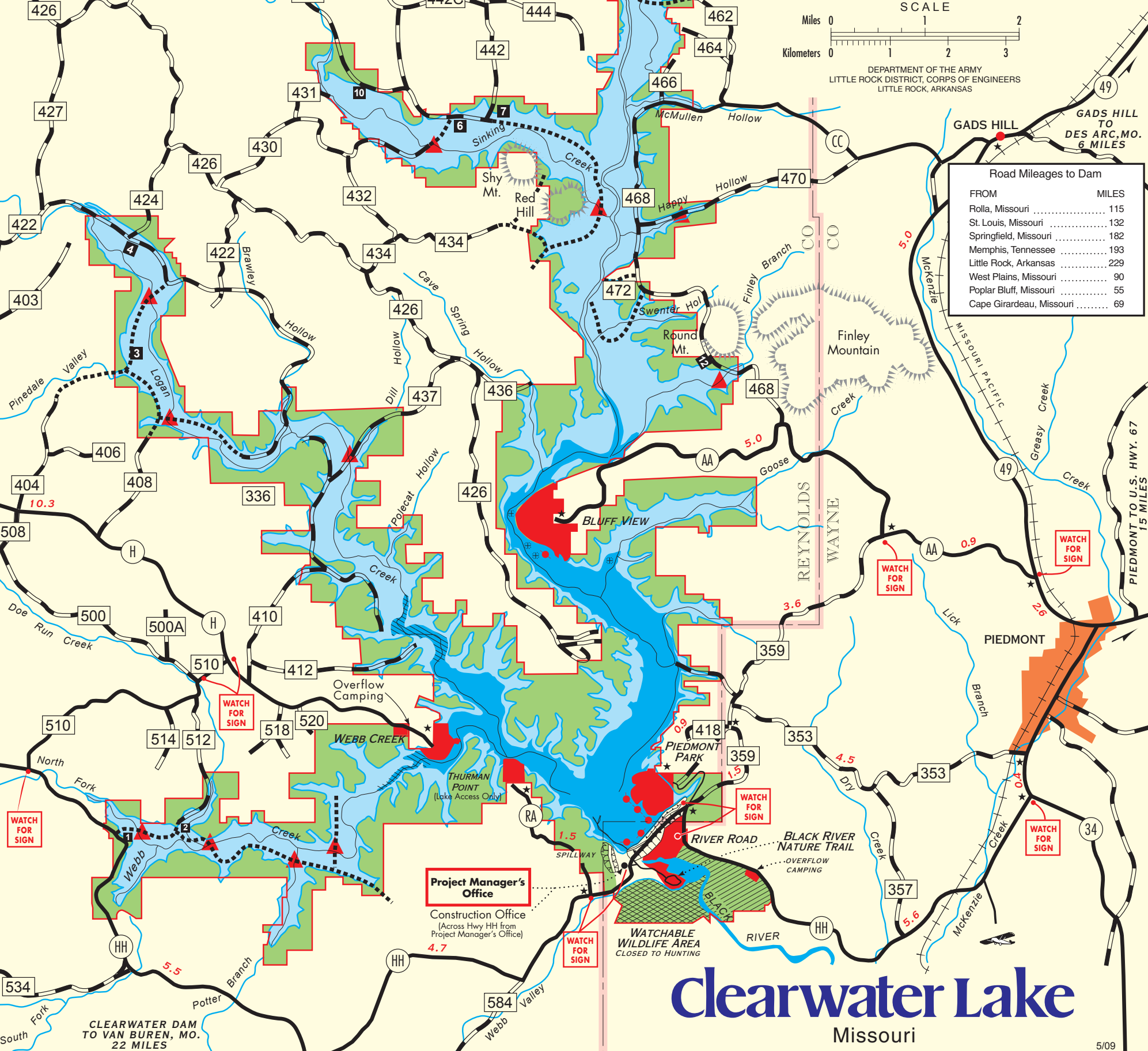
LEGEND
