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PERMIT PROVISIONS

- A. It is understood that the above named group or individual will abide by all regulations and restrictions applicable to Little Rock District Recreational Areas (copy enclosed) and that they will be responsible for cleanup of the area during and after the period occupied. It is the responsibility of each camper to see that all waste (trash, garbage, human, and animal) is removed from the Project prior to departure.
- B. It is understood that this area is made available on a "use at your own risk" basis. The Little Rock District will not be held liable for personal injuries, or loss of or damage to private property.
- C. It is understood that the "Responsible Party" will be held accountable for that camping area.
- D. All campers associated with group camps will have to leave the area on the departure date.
- E. All fires will be confined to a designated area for this purpose. Care will be exercised in building and extinguishing fires to prevent damage to trees and vegetation and to prevent forest and grass fires.
- F. The installation of any permanent facility is prohibited.
- G. The permittee will not cut any trees, dig any holes, or remove any natural vegetation or other materials from the areas. Firewood may be collected from fallen trees only.
- H. ALL camping units (trailers, motor homes, etc.), must be properly licensed with license displayed on the camping unit at ALL times while set up on project lands. Failure to comply with this provision may result in the removal of the camp unit (impoundment) at the owner's expense or receiving a citation and directed to leave the project.
- I. Primitive Camping Permits will be issued for a MAXIMUM of 28 days per primitive camping area. At that time, both the camp unit and the camper must move either to another primitive camping area, a campground or off the project. The camper and camp unit may return to the previous camp spot after 7 days.
- J. Extensions are granted with the provision that it can be revoked by the Lake Manager at any time it is deemed necessary for proper management of the park and facilities.
