

Description of Completed Project Southside Water, White River, AR

The project area is located along the south bank (right bank) of the White River in the vicinity of the Southside Water Treatment Plant just south of the river from Batesville, AR, in Independence County. This project consists of placing 1,700 ft of Longitudinal Fill Stone Toe Protection (LFSTP) with full bank paving and keys along the right (south) bank of the White River between RM 301 and RM 300.5. The project also includes clearing, grubbing, excavation, topsoil stripping, and turfing. The project protects Southside Public Water Authority facilities from flood damage, including the intake structure, main water line, and transmission lines from the pumping station to the treatment plant. The Project Partnership Agreement (PPA) was signed June 14, 2011 with the local sponsor, Southside Public Water Authority. Construction started March 2012 and was completed in May 2012. Total costs were \$783,500, and were cost shared 65/35 with the sponsor.
