Dana, Please see my comments in RED in your original email below.

Three questions we would like to ask to help us focus on concerns and issues around the lake:

How would you like to see Table Rock Lake in 20 years?

We should position Table Rock to be the cleanest lake in America, recognized for exceptional recreational activities, world class fishing, camping and marina facilities. This will require lots of work to clean up old septic systems around the water, continued control of docks and shoreline management and upgrading and addition of camping facilities.

What about Table Rock Lake is most important to you?

I like to feel safe when going on the water. This means exceptional water quality where I don't have to worry whether my family will become sick after swimming. I also want to be able to swim/boat/fish without worrying about larger, faster boats creating huge wakes and lots of noise. Simply, we cannot allow Table Rock to become Lake of the Ozarks where it's life-threatening every time you go out. Table Rock should remain Family Friendly.

What is one thing that could be done to improve the lake?

Limit the size and speed of some boats - especially the cigarette-type boats which create noise, endanger other boats and are of little use other than going fast.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter because of the frustration I have experienced for the past 16 years trying to run a business. I purchased 17 acres of land in 1976 with approximately 800 foot of Table Rock Lake frontage. I had been in the process of developing a resort for many years and opened it on a permanent basis in 1996. I now have a full basketball court, a volleyball court, a batting cage, golf carts, other land facilities and access to water sports. We have a lodge where at times as many as 42 individuals have resided for vacation time. We do not have individual units but the lodge is divided so that seven individual families could have their area. As a retired teacher my income is not great but I have paid taxes on between \$15,000 and \$20,000 each of the 16 years of the resorts existence.

My concern is with the access that is provided by the Corp of Engineers for my resort. It is my understanding that a resort is entitled to 1 1/2 slips per unit. I have never inquired as to how many slips would be provided because there is not a place for me to have a private dock because Big M marina has all the areas in Rock Creek tied up with their satellite areas. I have done the following to try and cope with these existing rules.

1. I loaned Denver Dixon money to build a dock that could be used for the resort.
2. I have tried to rent enough slips to accommodate the resort.
3. I have contacted the Corp about the problems.

Below are some of the problems that have impeded the development of my resort.

1. The resort has been limited to two slips by Big M.
2. The resort was not able to access its slips from the shore because of high water for a period of more than three weeks.
3. Big M has received many complaints about the large numbers of people from the resort using the dock.

Since the inception of the resort in 1976, individuals have become more involved. Some of these individuals have purchase lots on the 17 acres of the resort and will serve on a board of directors for a trust set up to run the resort upon my death. Five of these individuals rent a total of 8 slips from Big M on a boat dock in Rock Creek. It is my contention that the rule that an individual can't have a boat dock within 3 road miles of a marina devalues my land and causes undue hardships. There are several boat docks closer by water to Big M than the one we have to rent in Rock Creek.

I realize that this meeting is for a more general public and that my situation is much more unique. Please let me know who I can contact to further discuss my problems.

How would you like to see Table Rock Lake in 20 years? I would like to see Table Rock maintain quality while still allowing it to be accessible. The increased usage does not have to damage the ambiance of the lake if the Corps of Engineers will restrict certain activities which are excessively disruptive and damaging:

a) **Loud Boats** – There appears to be a trend to add "Captain's Calls" to boats which bypasses the muffler. These boats disproportionately interfere with the enjoyment of the lake. Many times you can hear one of these boats coming five miles down the lake. Captain's Calls should be prohibited and the Corps should set a decibel limit on noise coming from water craft.

(b) **High Speed** – I would suggest that the Corps place a speed limit on the lake of 50 mph at least in the smaller areas of the lake west of Kimberling.

What about Table Rock Lake is most important to you? Water Quality and Noise Levels.

What is one thing that could be done to improve the lake? Place decibel limits and speed limits on the lake.

Additional comments on the Master Plan Revision or about issues that should be studied.

I believe the concession contracts which don't allow community docks within a distance of the commercial boat docks and the rules by which satellite docks are established are unfair and operate to grant monopolies which under the rules generate excessive profits. The concessionaires to build a dock for \$6,000.00 per stall which they then rent for \$1,200.00 per year. Even considering expenses this could amount to a 20% rate of return that is created by the Corps regulations. I would suggest that the rates being charged for satellite docks have some reasonable correlation to the investment.

The Corps should allow boat slips to be rented to individuals so long as the owner does not own more than two slips and they are rented for a reasonable amount. In the community dock I am in, we have three retired individuals who because of their age and infirmity are unable to utilize their boats. They don't want to sell their slip because if they do they will have a problem selling their home without a slip. The dock assessments are \$400.00 per year. This is a large amount for these individuals. If they could rent their slip to recover their assessment that would be helpful.

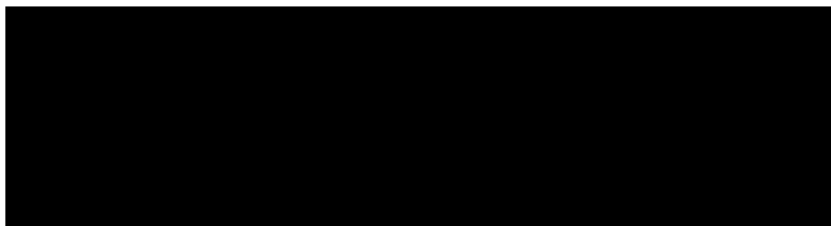

I have had shotgun pellets rain down on my home and dock from duck & goose hunters. No one seems to care as long as the hunters are on Corps ground!

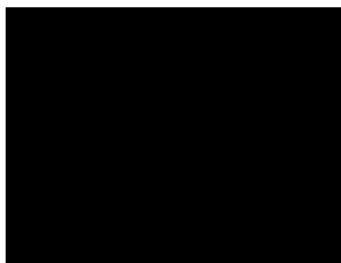

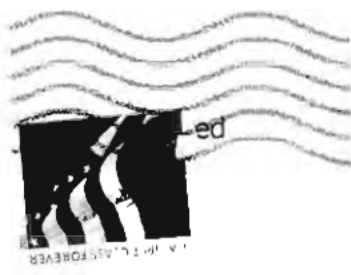

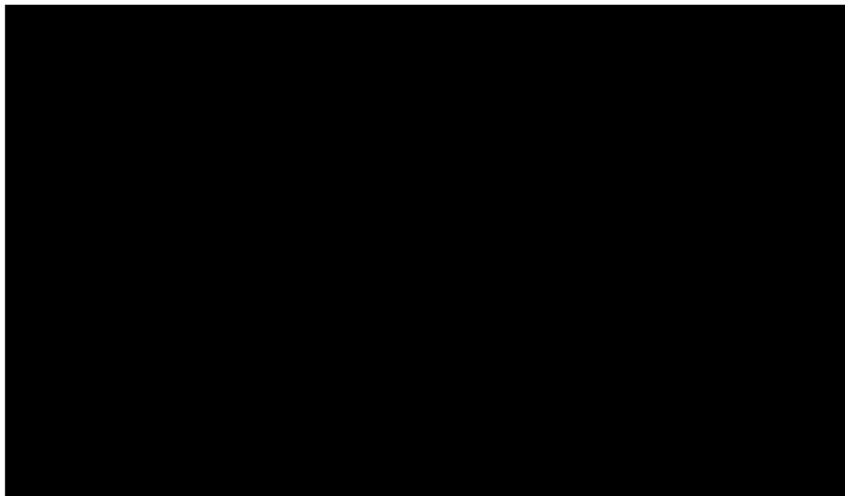
