MEMORANDUM FOR Table Rock Project Office Personnel

SUBJECT: Project Policy #13-11, Electrical Power to Private/Community Boat Docks

1. Effective immediately, no new electric lines will be authorized from private property to docks. New electrical power to docks must be supplied from an alternative source (i.e. solar power). Power systems on boat docks must meet all local and state codes and requirements and the National Electrical Code (NEC). Particular attention should be given to Article 55 of the NEC. Prior to installation, a certified electrician or Registered Professional Electrical Engineer must develop plans indicating that the system will meet Corps standards along with those referenced above. Additionally, a copy of the Electrical Certification Form must be completed and provided to the Table Rock Project Office before a shoreline use permit will be issued or re-issued.
2. Existing underground or overhead power lines will be allowed to remain so long as they are maintained in safe working condition and meet Corps standards (including license/easement and Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) conditions) and all local and state codes and the requirements of the NEC.
3. This policy will go into effect immediately.
