DISCUSSION FORUM RESPONSES

Question: Will there be an opportunity for the Corps of Engineers to increase the capacity of the \$50 million dollar MATOC's over the five year period?

Response: **The instant MATOCs will not exceed the maximum limitation of \$50M per contract award. Task order limitations have not been established. Typically, single task orders limitations are the range \$5M; \$10M; etc.**

Question: Will the Government consider SDVOB, 8(a), and SB set aside?

Response: **The Determination has not been made to set aside these acquisitions. Feedback from market research will help us determine specific procurement methods. We will structure these acquisitions to afford maximum competitive opportunities for all capable, responsive, and responsible contractors.**

Question: What % of small business will be required for large business participation?

Response: **Subcontracting plans will likely include our Department of Army goals:**  
**Small Business 32%**  
**Small Disadvantaged Business 18%**  
**Women-Owned Small Business 5.8%**  
**HUBZone Small Business 10%**  
**Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business 3%**  
**HBCU/MI 13%**

Question: What type of work will be awarded under the VA MATOC per Shirley Bruce's presentation?

Response: **It is anticipated that the following types of work will be awarded for the VA MATOC in FY 10.**

Response: **The Little Rock District is unable to provide a web portal at this time.**

Question: During the meeting, it was mentioned that acquisitions anticipated are in accordance with FAR Part 15. Will Part 12 also apply?

Response: **The particular work anticipated is for Construction Services and thus construction is not a commercial item under the FAR, thus FAR Part 12 is not applicable.**

Question: Why not use existing IDIQ MATOC out of the Huntsville District?

Response: **Where possible we use existing regional contractual instruments to the degree residual capacity remains above the agency’s need.**
