Project Operations
SEAPLANE OPERATIONS

1. Purpose. This memorandum specifies those projects or portions of projects where seaplane operations are prohibited or restricted.
2. Applicability. This memorandum applies to all projects in the Little Rock District.
3. References:
 - a. 36 CFR Part 327.4.
 - b. 36 CFR Part 328.
4. Definition. A seaplane is an aircraft utilized for water landings and takeoffs.
5. Policy.
 - a. The operation of seaplanes is prohibited on Clearwater Lake.
 - b. Seaplanes may operate on all other projects under the jurisdiction of the Little Rock District. Seaplane landings and takeoffs are restricted within 2,600 feet of any lock, dam, causeway, or bridge crossing, and within 500 feet of any recreation area or public launching area.
 - c. The general regulations governing the operation of seaplanes as contained in 36 CFR Part 327.4(f) are applicable to all Little Rock District projects where seaplane operation is permitted.
