SALE OR STORAGE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY COMMERCIAL CONCESSIONS

1. Purpose. This memorandum provides the policies and guidance for the sale or storage of alcoholic beverages by commercial concessions.
2. Applicability. This memorandum applies to all projects in the Little Rock District.
3. References:
 - a. ER 1130-2-400
 - b. Arkansas Alcoholic Control Act
 - c. Liquor Control Law and Nonintoxicating Beer, Missouri
4. Policy.
 - a. General. ER 1130-2-400 provides that District Commanders may authorize concessionaires to dispense malt beverages and light wines in a manner that will conform to State and local laws and to the standards and atmosphere which we wish to have maintained on our projects. Therefore, on a case by case basis, concessionaires may be granted permission to sell malt beverages and light wines in the original packages or by the drink when served with meals. Should it be determined that the sale of these products will conflict with the Corps' goal of maintaining a family atmosphere in the parks or will result in the creation of a safety hazard, permission will be denied.
 - b. Restriction on Advertisement. In no case will the sale of malt beverages and light wines be advertised on project lands including the leased premises.
