Project Operations  
RECREATION FREE DAY

1. Purpose. This regulation provides guidance for promoting project recreation resources through the use of a recreation free day.

2. Applicability. This regulation applies only to the user fee areas under the jurisdiction of the Little Rock District.

3. Reference. ER 1130-2-404 dated 2 July 1985.

4. Policy. The Resident Engineer/Manager may designate one consecutive day and night each calendar year as a Recreation Free Day (RFD). This designation will be subject to the following conditions:

a. The RFD should be held in conjunction with other public participation activities designed to promote resource management or public land stewardship activities. These would include, but are not limited to:

- (1) National Public Lands Day
- (2) The Great Arkansas Cleanup
- (3) Missouri Beautification Local Activities
- (4) National Hunting and Fishing Day

(5) Other (Requires justification and approval by the Chief, Construction-Operations Division).

b. All Corps user fee areas on the project(s) will be included in the RFD. The posted day use and camping fees would be waived for all users for the one specified day and night.

c. Prepaid reservation fees for picnic shelters, group camps, etc., will not be refunded. Special events occurring on the RFD will be subject to the Special Event Permit fee.



d. Maximum publicity will be given to the RFD. The Resident Engineer/Manager will coordinate all media releases through the Chief, Public Affairs Office, and furnish copies to the Chief, Construction-Operations Division.

e. The Resident Engineer/Manager will provide the Chief, Construction-Operations Division, a brief report assessing the effectiveness of the RFD. The report will include an estimate of the number of day users and campers participating, and a summary of visitor comments. The report should be furnished within 30 days after the Recreation Free Day.
