
DISTRICT COMMANDER'S POLICY MEMORANDUM NO 02-12

SUBJECT: Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization Policy

1. References:

- a. Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 19 Small Business Programs.
- b. Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) Part 219 Small Business Programs.
- c. Army Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (AFARS) Part 19 Small Business Programs.
- d. Engineers Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement (EFARS) Part 19 Small Business Programs.

2. It is the District policy to place a fair proportion of its acquisitions, both prime contracts and subcontracts, with small business concerns, historically underutilized business concerns, women-owned small business concerns, and historically black colleges and universities and minority institutions.
3. Contracting and technical personnel will remain knowledgeable of the provisions of the small and small disadvantaged business program requirements and take all reasonable action to meet or exceed the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) goals.
4. The Deputy for Small Business will be the point of contact for appropriate small business issues, CESWL-DB, 501-324-6965.
