SUBJECT: Policy Statement, Shoreline Management of the
McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation Pools

1. This policy statement was developed in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 4.c. of ER 1130-2-406 dated 31 Oct 90, subject: Shoreline Management at Civil Works Projects. It is applicable to each of the navigation projects on the Arkansas portion of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System. This policy statement is not applicable to Lake Dardanelle which is already covered by a shoreline management plan, or Ozark Lake which is covered in another policy statement.

2. The Government did not purchase a controlling band of fee owned land around the navigation pools. Certain blocks of land were purchased in fee for recreation and project operation purposes. There were no private docks moored along the shoreline owned in fee, and there were no known privately maintained paths or other private uses (including, but not limited to, mowing or removal of grasses, shrubs and small trees) authorized by permit or other written commitment on the project lands owned in fee as of the date ER 1130-2-406 was issued. Therefore:

a. Private uses including, but not limited to mooring of docks, construction of paths to the shoreline, mowing or removal of grasses, shrubs and small trees will not be permitted on navigation project lands owned in fee.

b. In the event there are any existing private facilities or activities authorized by a permit or other written commitment, they will be grandfathered.

c. Private uses including dredging, placement of fill, construction of fixed or combination fixed-floating structures and discharge of dredged material on reaches of the shoreline not owned in fee by the Government will be evaluated under authority of Section 10 and/or Section 404 permit requirements by the Regulatory Branch, Construction-Operations Division.

d. Applications to place only private floating facilities (boat docks) on privately owned shoreline along the navigation pools of the System will be evaluated under authority of Section 10 permit requirements. Shoreline Use Permits are not required for facilities covered by a Section 10 or 404 permit.


