

Welcome To Greers Ferry Lake

Please Read And Observe The Following Park Rules:

1. **VEHICLES-PARK & OPERATE VEHICLES ONLY ON PAVED SURFACES.** No parking on launch ramp or adjacent to swim beach. No ATV's.
2. **CAMPING**-Campsite occupancy is limited to eight persons. Campsite equipment is limited to 2 tents OR 1 tent and 1 wheeled camping unit (not 2 trailers). Check with park attendant before occupying any campsite.
3. **FIRES** – Only permitted in grills, fireplace, and fire rings provided. Put fire out before you leave. Only fallen dead wood can be collected for firewood. Do not use fireplace/fire ring for trash. During burn bans, only gas type grills are permitted.
4. **TREES AND VEGETATION** – Do not cut, chop, or break limbs from trees or shrubs.
5. **QUIET HOURS** – 10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m. Violation of quiet hours may result in citation and/or expulsion from the park. All vehicles that enter park after 10:00 p.m. must display a camper pass to gain entry. Failure to display camper pass after 10:00 p.m. may result in no entry to the campground.
6. **PETS** – Must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet and under control at all times. Pets that are deemed to be aggressive, vicious or a nuisance may be required to be removed from the park. Pets are not allowed in swim beach areas.
7. **FIREWORKS AND WEAPONS** – Are prohibited.
8. **TRASH**—Trash cans are no longer provided at campsites. Please place trash in centrally located dumpsters. Do not leave trash at campsite.
9. **DAY USE**—(Swim Beach/Picnic Areas) ends at 10:00 p.m. Do not park on campsites unless camping on the site. Check with park attendants before occupying any campsite.
10. For a complete listing of all park regulations, obtain a copy of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, at the park entrance. Violation of park regulations may result in citation and/or expulsion from the park.
