



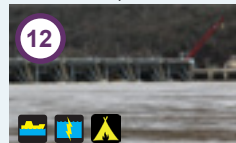

Navigation System

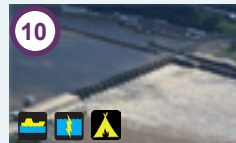

Budget / Projects:

- \$115,452,000 for O&M in FY21 (President's Budget).
- \$10,252,150 in FY21 Work Plan (Civil Works)
- \$7,135,000 in FY21 for other regular Appropriations (Civil Works)
- Received \$129,230,000 in FY19 Flood Supplemental Appropriations; Obligated \$114,454,000 in FY20
- 1,301 total Contracting actions, valued at \$408,141,064, were executed in FY20.
- Three Rivers project is being designed to preserve navigation access to the Mississippi River.
- Anticipate a significant customer funded hydropower recapitalization program into the foreseeable future.
- The White River Basin Study, conducted in conjunction with Arkansas State University, is being done to examine all uses of water in the basin and how well the system provides resources to meet those needs.
