





Civil Works Budget / Projects:

- \$114,566,000 for O&M for FY20 (President's Budget)
- \$10,680,000 for FY20 Work Plan
- \$11,786,000 in Other Appropriations for FY20
- Received additional Flood Supplemental Appropriations in the amount of \$115,044,000
- Three Rivers project is being designed to preserve navigation access to the Mississippi River.
- Anticipate a significant customer funded hydropower recapitalization program into the forseeable future.
- The White River Basin Study, conducted in conjunction with Arkansas State University, is being done to examine all uses of water in the basin and how well the system provides resources to meet those needs.
