








Budget / Projects:

- \$293.5 million in FY22 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Funding
- -\$109.1 million to physically complete and fiscally close out the 3 Rivers Project -\$12.4 million for O&M at Bull Shoals, Norfork, and Clearwater lakes -\$72.3 million in O&M funds to provide reliable navigation on the MKARNS
- -\$7 million for Continuing Authorities Program
 -\$92.6 million for the MKARNS 12-Foot Channel Study in Arkansas and Oklahoma
 (Funds received in the IIJA FY22 Addendum)
- \$163.6 million in the President's FY 2023 Budget
 - -\$74.7 million for O&M at 12 reservoirs across Arkansas and southern Missouri -\$88.9 million in O&M funds to provide reliable navigation on the MKARNS
- \$69.7 million in FY23 Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Funding
- -\$62.7 million for O&M funds to provide reliable navigation on the MKARNS -\$4.2 million for emergency repairs to the Okay Levee at Millwood Lake -\$2 million for crane rehab design & repair at Nimrod Lake -\$850,000 to complete crane repairs at Clearwater Lake
- 1,130 total contracting actions valued at \$239 million were executed in FY21.
- Anticipate a significant customer funded hydropower recapitalization program in the foreseeable future.
- Received \$131.5 million in FY19 Flood Supplemental Appropriations (O&M + FCCE). Obligated \$128.4 million as of Feb. 1, 2022
