Boaters should watch for submerged timber, snags and other unknown hazards resulting from variation in pool levels.

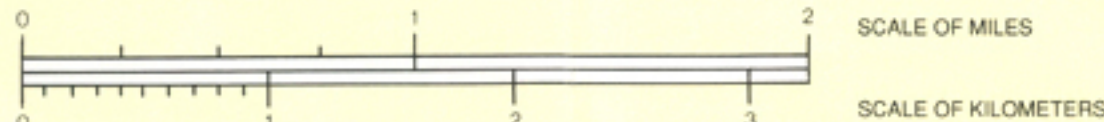
When winds of 25 M.P.H. or more are forecast or blowing, boats should stay out of open water.
