The Army Corps of Engineers, Little Rock District, is releasing the draft revision to the Greers Ferry Lake Shoreline Management Plan (SMP). The SMP for Greers Ferry Lake establishes policy and furnishes guidelines for the protection and preservation of the desirable environmental characteristics of the shoreline while maintaining a balance between public and private shoreline use. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) an Environmental Assessment of potential impacts of the draft plan has also been prepared.
