WELCOME TO NORFORK AND BULL SHOALS LAKE

So that everyone can have a safe and enjoyable visit and to preserve your parks, please remember:

CHECKOUT TIME: 3:00 P.M.

CHECK IN TIME: 4:00 P.M.

- Register at the entrance station before setting up your camp.
- Dispose of all waste properly. Dumpsters for trash are centrally located and gray water must be disposed at the trailer dump station.
- Reduce congestion by camping only on designated sites and limiting the number of motor vehicles at your site. Park only in designated areas.
- Campsite capacity is limited to one wheeled camping unit and one tent or two tents.
- Firearms are not permitted in developed parks and fireworks are not permitted on any public land and water areas.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. At other times, be considerate of others by keeping noise levels low.
- Pets are welcome, but they must be kept on a six feet or shorter leash and should not be left unattended. For sanitary reasons, pets are prohibited in swimming areas.
- Swimming areas are unsupervised. Keep an eye on children and wear personal flotation devices (life jackets).

Glass containers and alcoholic beverages are not permitted in swimming areas.
