

DESCRIPTION OF LAND CLASSIFICATIONS



HIGH DENSITY RECREATION

- Day use areas and/or campgrounds
- Commercial concessions (marinas)
- Other commercial-type activities



LOW DENSITY RECREATION

- Passive public recreational use--primitive camping, fishing, hunting, trails, wildlife viewing
- Low Density Recreation lands may contain Limited Development Areas within the context of the Shoreline Management Plan (SMP)—boat docks, veg mod permits



ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIVE AREA (ESA) (1975 NATURAL AREA)

- Scientific, ecological, cultural or aesthetic features
- Public use which does not adversely impact these lands--fishing, hunting, wildlife viewing, photography
- Small percentage of ESA lands have permitted residential and municipal amenities (county roads, private roads, public utilities, etc.)



WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

- Food plots
- Agricultural activities



PROJECT OPERATIONS

- Dam, spillway, switchyard, levees, dikes, offices, maintenance facilities, water intake structures
