

MEETING PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

 TRLOC Termination process—What does this mean for committee members?







- Once a committee has completed their "actions", they can be put into an administrative suspend status until they are officially terminated.
 - Administrative suspend status = The committee is "inactive".
 - The current 2 year committee charter will still be in effect; however, the committee is supposed to be inactive during "Administrative suspend" status and the committee charter will not be renewed during "Administrative suspend" status.
 - The members SF50 will no longer be effective. For TRLOC, all committee
 members are Special Government Employees or SGEs and all have a SF50. The
 SF50 is a notification of personnel action form. In the case of the TRLOC
 members, everyone got a SF50 when they became a SGE.
 - The current SF50s for the 6 SGE members will end on 11 December 2020.







OFFICIAL TERMINATION

- The TRLOC was authorized and created by the Water Resources Development Act of 2016.
- The TRLOC will require language in a bill, then signed into law by the President, in order to be officially terminated.
