## **Table Rock Lake Oversight Committee Meeting Minutes**

The committee heard a presentation by Trish Tannehill, Corps GIS specialist, on the carrying capacity study, and a presentation on solar power for docks from Corps Deputy Operations Project Manager Rodney Raley, and Nathan Jones with Power Source Solar.

The committee heard additional public comment, followed by a presentation by Becky Shortt, Table Rock Lake operations project manager, on the Commercial Remote Service Dock program. Additional discussion followed.

Chairman Jahnke recessed the meeting at 10:59 a.m. so the committee members could work individually to review notes and formulate questions. The meeting was reconvened at 11:20 a.m.

The committee recommended revising the language in the section of the shoreline management plan regarding penalties for floating facilities rule violations to clarify that only an individual slip holder in a community dock would be penalized for rule violations, not the entire dock.

The committee also asked the Corps to further study options for the removal of cedar trees for review at the next meeting.
