As the DFO for the TRLOC meeting this week, I wanted you to have these documents prior to the meeting. I had planned on presenting them in person to the DFO during the public comment period. I will be commenting on all six packets.

Each TLOC member has already received their own packet. They were delivered after the comments were placed on the TRLOC website in May. Interestingly, the packet titled "US Court of Federal Claims finds USACE liable" has been posted three times to the website; in May, June and July. This comment has yet to be released by the USACE for public consumption.

On the TRLOC website, the presentation on cedar trees by Jerry Judge is posted. Will the presentation by Rodney Raley on clarifying language on dock violations be available for review prior to the meeting?
